

## Pack 32 Official Cabin Camping Policy

- Alcohol is strictly prohibited.
- During the trip, each Cub Scout and sibling will be the responsibility of a parent/guardian.
- (2) BALOO trained adults must attend the trip (The Pack is always in need of more BALOO trained adults! If interested, please ask a Pack Leader for more information)
- All adults are expected to help on the trip. For example: shopping for the Pack food, cooking, running a game or activity, etc...
- Youth Protection Training rules are to be followed at all times! No adult should ever be alone with a youth, unless that youth is their own child. If
- The scouts will follow the buddy system at all times.
- No open-toed shoes at camp!
- In addition to your sleeping bags or other comfortable bedding, pillows, flashlights, etc., the following is a checklist of items you may want to consider bringing:
  - personal first aid kit
  - backpack (small day pack for use when moving between camp areas during the day)
  - water bottle
  - ground cover
  - insect repellent
  - Sunscreen
  - toothbrush & paste
  - toilet paper
  - Towel
  - hand soap
  - Washcloth
  - prescription medications
  - personal snacks or drinks
  - camp chairs
  - spare socks/shoes
  - air mattress (if the cabin bunks do not have mattresses)
